Senate Judiciary Committee hearings begin September 4 on President **Donald Trump's** nomination of Judge **Brett Kavanaugh** to serve on the U.S. Supreme Court.

### TALKING POINTS ON BRETT KAVANAUGH

#### Judge Kavanaugh has stellar qualifications to serve on the Supreme Court

- Graduated from Yale College in 1987 and Yale Law School in 1990, where he distinguished himself as a Notes Editor for the Yale Law Journal
- Clerked for Supreme Court **Justice Anthony Kennedy**
- Served President **George W. Bush** as White House Counsel and as Assistant to the President and White House Staff Secretary
- Currently sits on the U.S. Court of Appeals for the D.C. Circuit (commonly seen as the second most important court in the nation)

#### Judge Kavanaugh has a record of solid judicial opinions

- Authored over 300 opinions during his 12 years on the D.C. Circuit Court of Appeals
- Holds the distinction of having his positions endorsed by the U.S. Supreme Court in

- 13 decisions (with only one reversal)
- Is considered a constitutionalist and believes the judge's job is to interpret the law, not to make the law or to make policy

### **Judge Kavanaugh has a strong record with women**

- Eighteen of Judge Kavanaugh's female law clerks have signed a letter praising his unsurpassed qualifications
- Judge Kavanaugh's female law clerks speak highly of the support and mentorship he provided, stating unequivocally that he "has been one of the strongest advocates in the federal judiciary for women lawyers."

### **Liberals are using obstructionist tactics to delay confirmation**

- The Senate vetted and confirmed Judge Kavanaugh to the D.C. Court of Appeals by a vote 57-36 in 2006
- Hearings start 57 days after Judge Kavanaugh's nomination, longer than Justice Kagan (49 days), Sotomayor (48 days) or Gorsuch (48 days)
- The most vocal demands for more documents are coming from those who have already announced their opposition
