- **Reforming Government:** Pushed for reforms to make government more efficient and effective; introduced the “One Subject at a Time Bill,” designed to compel Congress to pass transparent legislation without handing out special privileges to special interests.
- **Putting Utah First** in every vote she takes; working to protect Utah’s resources, protect businesses in Utah from onerous taxation, and ensure funding for state transportation projects.
- **Helping the Middle Class:** While still a freshman in Congress, passed legislation to expand access to credit for middle-class families and small-business owners.
- **Tackling the Big Issues:** During the 114th Congress, introduced or co-introduced 10+ pieces of legislation addressing issues such as college affordability, medical doctor shortages, veterans' benefits, access to credit, and labor issues; worked with her colleagues and co-sponsored more than 160 pieces of legislation addressing issues such as overspending, immigration, poverty, veterans’ benefits, healthcare, education, energy, and much more.
