VALE—In a precautionary measure today, [Senator Lynn Findley](#) (R-Vale) has closed his physical office location in Vale and his legislative office in Salem to help limit the spread of COVID-19 in vulnerable communities.

Out of an abundance of caution, I am temporarily closing my physical offices in Vale and Salem and I will still be working diligently to ensure there is no lapse in service to my constituents in District 30,” said Findley. “Thank you especially to our service workers, public health professionals, and first responders who are working tirelessly to keep Oregonians safe through this challenging and unprecedented time.”
